# Farmington Wins 1st Under Coach Brown

The fourth time around proved fruitful for Coach Bruce Brown and his Farmington High cagers. After suffering three solid lashings, the Falcons broke into the win column over Waterford, 60-59, for Brown's first triumph since taking over the reins this season.

The Falcons fell behind after one quarter, 13-9, and stayed with Waterford to trail by the same margin at the half, 30-28. Farmington put it together in the third, out-scoring its opponents, 18-12 to carry a 44-42 lead into the final eight minutes.

With 12 seconds remaining, Farmington found itself down by one but Falcon Bill Nara found the hoop on a pass from Joe Montgomery and it was victory No. 1.

"Our countless turnovers kept Waterford in the game," said Brown. "We are averaging 25 a game...we have to slice this number."

# Spartan Defense Tips WL Western

One word described the Western Wallled Lake Western basketball contest - defense.

The Spartans of Stevenson jarred Western in a non-jarred, 43-34, to stand 2-2 before the Churchill Holiday Tournament.

"This had to be our top defensive effort yet," said Stevenson Coach George VanWagoner. "We held them to 12 points in the first half and only 22 in the second half."

Stevenson led after the first quarter, 11-4, and 27-12 at the half. Western outscored Stevenson in the final two periods, 22 to 16.

WESTERN TOOK 19 more shots than Stevenson but mustered only a 17 per cent shooting accuracy on 13 of 76.

The Spartans hit on 18 of 57 for 37 per cent.

"Our defense constantly

forced Western into taking the poor shots," said VanWagoner.

The Spartans outrebounded the Western Six contenders, 52-34, with 33 of those in the defensive board. Dale Haberman paced Stevenson with 14, followed by Mike Patrick with 11.

"Defense has to be our answer to winning," added VanWagoner. "Our offense is just not producing."
