Irish-born Israeli diplomat and writer, Yaacov Morris, will be the guest speaker at the 43rd annual donor tea of Women of the Jewish National Fund. This will be held at 12 noon, Tuesday, Jan. 23, in Congregation Beth Achim, 21109 W. 12 Mile, Southfield.
