Now It's 97 Birthdays For Jennie Zingelmann

Nine big candles and seven small ones marked a happy birthday Feb. 23 for a lady who was born in Farmington 97 years ago and has lived there most of her life.

"You bet I blew all the candles out," said Mrs. Jennie Zingelmann, for the last year a resident of a nursing home in Union Lake.

Mrs. Zingelmann had a chance to visit again with relatives and former neighbors at a party given by her niece, Mrs. Kay Briggs.

Mrs. Briggs and her husband, Robert, live on Farmington's Oxford Street, and their property once was part of the farm where Mrs. Zingelmann grew up.

Jennie Zingelmann was born in the village of Farmington in 1876. "Pa was working for the post office then," she said.

Moving to the farm when she was three, she attended elementary grades at the Noble School, which later became the Farmington school district's special education headquarters and office home to Mrs. Briggs.

"Mostly I walked to school," she said. "It was two miles. When it was real cold Pa got a horse."

There were six in her family as she grew up. Mrs. Zingelmann, the oldest, and one brother, now living in Phoenix are the only ones still living.

She graduated from Farmington High School in 1892 and taught for a year at the Noble School at 13 W. 7th and Farmington Road before marrying Will Zingelmann in 1896. "On my birthday," she remembers.

They lived for a time in Ohio and two of their three children were among those burned to death in the tragic Collinwood school fire in

Cleveland in the early part of this century.

Moving back to Farmington in 1933, they lived on Nine Mile Road.

Will Zingelmann died 21 years ago and their son, George, died three weeks later.

Mrs. Zingelmann was a correspondent for the Farmington Enterprise for a number of years. She has six grandchildren and 17 great-grandchildren.

A charter member of the Farmington Historical Society, she also was active for years in the Eastern Star, and her birthday brought a card shower from members of both groups.

On hand for the birthday party were former neighbors Helen Gregor and Mildred Roughley, longtime friends Violet Majeski, Mrs. C.M. Carlson, and Mrs. LaGene Wagoner.

Bella Zingelmann, her daughter-in-law, Gladys J. Cox, a niece, and Mr. and Mrs. Briggs.

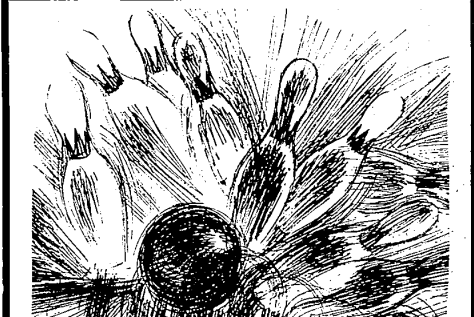
