Girl Scouts Will Sell Millions Of Cookies

Nearly one million boxes of delicious cookies will arrive in the Detroit area soon—in time for the annual cookie sale of the Girl Scouts of Metropolitan Detroit, scheduled for March 9-18.

Through the cooperation of merchants and other businessmen, Girl Scout troops will set up cookie booths in more than 500 stores, banks and other neighborhood shops during that time.

Since the Girl Scouts of the Metropolitan Detroit Council are not permitted to sell cookies door-to-door, the booths make it possible for them to sell to the public.

Responsibility for the successful operation of the cookie sale is withered in addition to the efforts of the scouts and the cooperation of their parents, nearly 1,700 volunteers help organize and conduct the sale.

These include 1,650 troop cookie managers, 105 volunteers who coordinate the sale for troops in their neighborhoods, 22 other cookie managers in large geographic areas and 18 members of a committee to assign troops to booths.

Secretaries Will Meet In Detroit

Nearly 1,200 secretaries, aspiring secretaries and persons interested in learning new office techniques are expected to attend a workshop in Cobo Hall March 3. The event is being sponsored by the Greater International Metropolitan Area Council (GIMAC) of the National Secretaries Association (International).

The schedule for the day includes workshop sessions in the morning, a luncheon and a keynote address by Russ Burgess, a parapsychologist.

The day will begin with registration and coffee at 8 a.m.

Those attending will then choose one long seminar or two short seminars from eight different sessions.

The long seminars are "Your Personal Performance Style," by Selma Conway Employee Development Office, U.S. Department of Defense; and "New Legal Rights of Women Today," by William A. Lucas, sheriff of Wayne County.

The shorter seminars include "The Art of Self-Protection," by Mrs. Margaret O'Brien, wife of E.D. O'Brien, former member of the House of Representatives; and "Word Processing," by Penny Young, manager of the systems support center for International Business Machines.

"Planning Makes the Difference"—from Office to Kitchen," will be conducted by Harold C. Gant, executive vice president of the Michigan Restaurant Association, and "Educational Goals for Women Today," by Janice Guerrero, director of business education at Oakland University.

The workshop is open to all secretaries or aspiring secretaries. Registration fee is \$10. This includes the luncheon. Checks should be
