Car Service Time Changes

The "summer schedule" goes into effect on the D. U. R. lines Tuesday morning, May 25th. The following changes for the Orchard Lake division as given by the Electric Railway Service bulletin are as follows:

The through service to Northville will be five minutes after the hour all the time with connections at Farmington Junction for Pontiac during the week days. In addition there will be hourly service for Grand Lawn and Redford from 5:35 a. m. to 7:35 p. m., making a half hourly service to these points from 5:35 a. m. to 8:05 p. m.

On Sundays this Grand Lawn and Redford, service, which then begins at 6:35 a. m., will continue through to Orchard Lake and Pontiac, thus giving half hourly service to the resorts, while this half hourly service on Saturdays will begin at 11:35 a. m.

The hourly service out of Northville will be 6:05 a. m., then 6:35 a. m. and hourly while the hourly cars out of Pontiac will be five minutes after the hour. There will also be an early morning and an afternoon service between Pontiac and Orchard Lake, which, on Saturdays and Sundays, is extended to Detroit to correspond with the half hourly service northbound.

When installed, the Orchard Lake limited will leave Pontiac at 7:05 a. m. and Orchard Lake at 6:55 a. m., while it will leave Detroit at 4:50 p. m. This limited will not run Saturday afternoon nor Sunday. The Northville limited will leave Detroit at 5 p. m. daily except Sunday.
