"'Purty good haul, eh?' sitting a loop shell in his red paste bed. 'Old time, too. How about that for ten shillings?'"


"Ten shillings! If he could throw away ten shillings for this ghastly thing—why hadn't she bought that sampler?"

"Was right there behind you." In her joy over the sampler, the awful box was forgotten.


