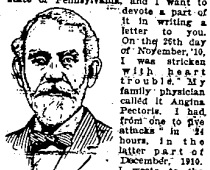

Midnight Blaze Causes Big Loss

ber Company was saved by the work of the Farmington squad of firefighters with chemical extinguishers which were rushed to the scene on the line car.

While the fire was at its height, reports of petty robberies were rampant, and the under sheriff from Detroit rushed to the scene with deputies, in a high-powered auto, and immediately placed men at each of the banks as a first precaution.

Merchandise was piled in the street, and before the eyes of hundreds, an auto drove up, loaded on anything in sight, and actually made away with the theft, every one thinking they were only being moved to a place of safety by their owner.

Mr. Otis was first notified of the fire at the Masonic lodge rooms, and rushed to the scene in an auto. He was followed by a score or more of local men in the line car which was hurriedly called, and a dozen or more autos.

This is the first fire of any moment in Redford; and came at a time when the village was entirely unprepared, as they are just now installing a system of waterworks. The Detroit fire company were compelled to pump water from the River Rouge, for a distance of a quarter of a mile, but the supply was inexhaustible, and resulted in a saving in property of thousands of dollars.

All of the destroyed property will at once be rebuilt and replaced.
