Local News

Frank F. Zessau was a Detroit business visitor, Wednesday.

Attorney James Lynch and family of Pontiac motored through Farmington Tuesday, and were visiting with friends near here.

Increase in mail receipts resulted in the rural carriers being given some additional desk space at the postoffice, the alteration in the carrier's quarters being made the first of the week.

It is announced that the paving on Orchard Lake avenue from the Pontiac city limits to the Toll Gate will be completed this week. The paving has been under course of construction for several weeks.

The campaign against speeders is on over at Royal Oak as well as here, where six were arrested by Officer F. J. the first of the week. The county roads throughout the county are in fact, being carefully watched.

A decision in the local option case is expected from the supreme court at Lansing today, where a full meeting of all the judges is scheduled for today, the first in several weeks. The case has been in the supreme court a trifle over a month.

The second carload of oil for street oiling purposes was received here last evening, and will be applied on the streets today and tomorrow. This is the second application to be given this season, the first one having been applied the latter part of April, and has done an unestimatable amount of good in laying the dust. With the amount of travel over the roads however, the second coat became a necessity, and will take care of the dust nuisance for the remainder of the season. Two oil sprinklers are being used for this application.

"That amateur farmer is doing his own sowing." "So is his wife."—Baltimore American.

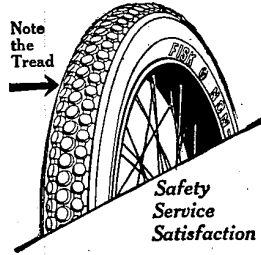
