

Pianist Will Perform Solo

The Plymouth Symphony will have a familiar soloist but a new starting time for the 1973-74 season.

Pianist Richard Syracuse will be guest artist when Conductor Wayne Dinsdale raises the baton on Thursday, Oct. 11 at 8 p.m. in Plymouth's Canton High School auditorium. Joy West of Canton Center Road (Ober season programs will be on the traditional Sunday afternoons at 4.)

A virtuoso in the Romantic tradition, Syracuse will perform Beethoven's fourth piano concerto, written in 1806, shortly after the "Appassionata" sonata and "Eroica" symphony, when Beethoven was at his peak.

Syracuse earned two degrees at Juillard school of music in his native New York and has won the Concert Artists Guild debut award (1964), one of five prizes in the Brussels' Queen Elizabeth International piano competition ('64), a Fulbright scholarship ('61, '62), and competitions sponsored by the Music Education League and New York State Federation of Music Clubs.

Other works on the program will be "Four Scottish Dances" by Arnold, "The White Peacock" by Griffes and "Hary Janos Suite" by Kodaly.

Tickets will be available at the door. K-12 students will be admitted free; but those below sixth grade must be accompanied by an adult. Literature on symphony society membership will be available the night of the concert.

GC Band Sets Concert
