Power also said that on Oct. 5, a second-of-the-week edition will be added to the Wednesday editions of the Western Observer and the Garden City Observer, and all other weekend editions of the papers would be delivered on Friday afternoon.

"Plans for this change were made many weeks prior to the recent newspaper shortage," said Power, "but we are expecting the strikes that caused the shortage to end and are taking other steps for the more efficient use of newsprint."
