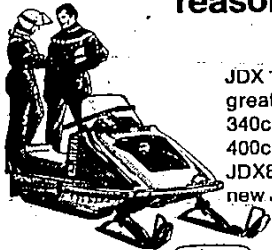

The Plymouth Symphony League's annual three-day antique mart opens at noon Friday, Sept. 7.

Formerly held in the Grange Building and the Community Building on Union Street, all 23 dealers will be together in the Plymouth Cultural Center back of Central Middle School on the corner of Farmer and Theodore streets.

Another innovation is the dress of the mart workers. Members of the Symphony League have completed brand new Shaker costumes for the ticket takers and hostesses.

A harvest theme will be carried out in the decorations.

Mrs. Mitchell sells weaving supplies and is the daughter of Peg Harding who used to have a booth at the show.

Charlotte McFarlane has one of the finest collections of local artifacts that have a special meaning to Plymouth residents. She also has Victorian items and old musical instruments.

Redford Township will be represented by three dealers; Helen Tallman, Bart Isaacsen and Dorothy Engler. Isaacsen has a fine selection of genuine Tiffany

lamps and designs his own Tiffany-type shades that outdo the old master.

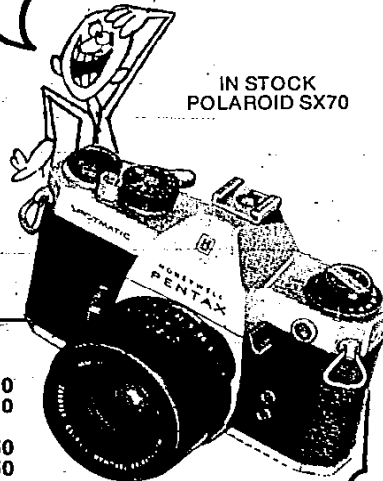
