**HEW Study**

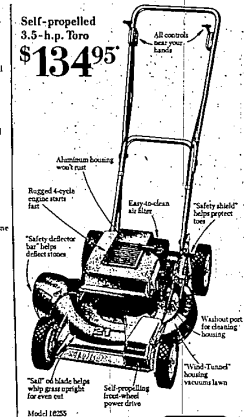

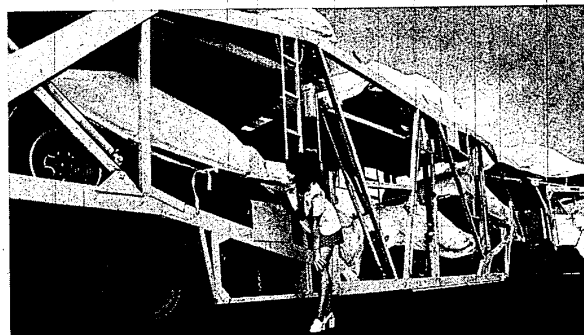
