Buddy Rich and his orchestra will kick off the 1973-74 Clarenceville Entertainment Series Sept. 29 and 30 in L.E. Schmidt Auditorium, 20155 Middle Belt Rd., Livonia. Concert time for both nights is 8:30 p.m.

Rich, the first big band artist to appear at Clarenceville in December 1969, is considered one of the world's greatest drummers. Other bands scheduled to appear this fall are Lionel Hampton, Oct. 21; Maynard Ferguson, Nov. 10 and 11; and Stan Kenton, Dec. 24. 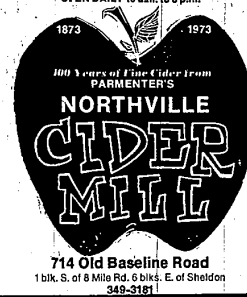
