Mills Buys New Plant

Mills Products, Inc. of Farmington, has purchased manufacturing facilities in Clarksville, Tenn.

Mills also has plants and subsidiaries in other Michigan communities and Ontario.

Mills is a major producer of fabricated handles, oven door assemblies and oven door windows, primarily for use in the home appliance and commercial cooking equipment industry.

The 26,000 square foot Tennessee plant is expected to provide more localized service, assembly and manufacturing capabilities. Scheduled to begin production in September, the plant will be operated as Mills Manufacturing Co.

A Young Firm Breaks Ground

The former Miss America, Pamela Eldred, helped CMP Industries, Inc., break ground for a new addition at 22995 Freeway Park Drive, Farmington Hills.

The \$500,000 structure in Freeway Industrial Park will house manufacturing facilities, administrative and engineering offices for the one-year-old firm.

Owners are Hal R. Brawley, president; Hal Carter, director of marketing; and Jim Pierce, sales manager. They also own the nearby Carter, McCormick & Peirce, Inc., a sales consultant and engineering firm serving the aerospace, mechanical control, automotive, consumer electronics and computer industries.

CMP Industries designs and manufactures seat belt testing machines, air bag test machines, carburetor testers, brake test systems and diagnostic equipment.

Employment currently is 45 and will be increased to 75 when the new building is completed in January, Carter said.

The building will have 22,000 square feet of space and parking facilities for 87 vehicles. It was designed by Kamp-DiCenzo Architects of Livonia and will be built by Thompson-Brown Co. of Farmington Hills.

Manufacturers Bank is handling construction financing and General American Life Insurance the mortgage. CMP Industries and its affiliate, Carter, McCormick & Peirce, Inc., have annual sales of \$8 million which are expected to increase by 20 per cent next year, Carter said.

NOTICE TO TAXPAYERS
