25th 'Mile' Dash Draws 14 Hopefuls

With a field of 14 starters, including several outstanding stars from the east and mid-west, Saturday's 25th renewal of the \$100,000 Michigan Mile and an eighth at the Detroit Race Course could be one of the most interesting in history.

The selection of spots was a highlight of the annual Michigan Mile brunch attended by more than 40 press, radio and television personalities as well as members of the Detroit Racing Association board of directors.

The rail position went to Roman Scout, a six-year-old owned by Wayne County Road Commissioner Michael Berry.

Area Girls Shine In Nationals

Nancy Gavoro, of Livonia, and Diane Panosian, of Farmington, captured honors in the Armenian Youth Federation National Olympics held in Toronto.

Miss Gavoro, a senior at Stevenson High who placed second in the state last year in the 220 yard dash, dashed to three national titles.

She won the 220 yard dash in :25.4; 440 in :58.0 and 880 in 2:39.4.

Miss Panosian, a senior at North Farmington High, won the girls' 25 and 50 yard freestyle events and placed second in the breaststroke.
