Garden Chatter

One pound tomatoes? Merely run-of-the-mill in this summer of 73 area gardens.
 Mrs. Edna Marquardt of 2236 Powers Rd. in Farmington has 1½ pounders on her climbing tomatoes. They grew so tall — eight to 10 feet — that they pulled their stakes right out of the ground.
 Mrs. Marquardt started the plants from seed and used sheep manure as the only fertilizer when she set them out. They are a deep pink color.
 The Charles Joneses who live on 13 Mile Road in Farmington Hills have four tomato plants that came up from seed.
 These healthy plants popped up in their onion patch and around the garden. They are producing 2½ pound beef steak tomatoes.
 The Jones' zucchinis are on the large size, too. Three of them weighed a total of 15 pounds.



The Green Thumb

You've been dreaming about a greenhouse for years, but think you can't afford it? Why not consider a window greenhouse?

It can make any window a year-round garden "room." Such a structure can be installed without mutilating the window frame or sash because they're built to fit the opening and rest upon the sill. You can heat and ventilate the window greenhouse from the adjoining room merely by opening the sash.

With a minimum of effort and expense, you can have that window greenhouse by using a tough, weatherable, plastic instead of glass. We prefer glass because it looks better on the window.

A solar window greenhouse makes any window come alive. You can get one all ready made of aluminum, in your choice of three colors: silver, gray, white and dark bronze, baked-on for permanent, life time beauty. Even an unhandy man or woman can put the solar window greenhouse together in five minutes. The only tool you need is a screwdriver to fasten the greenhouse to your window.

If you have a pair of windows side by side you can use two solar greenhouse windows. Greenhouse companies make the window greenhouses in 12 money-saving standard sizes that will fit most windows. If you have an odd size one, custom sizes are available.

To heat your greenhouse window, just open the house window in winter. Heat from your home will keep the greenhouse warm. In real cold areas, you'd better install a small electric heater. These can be purchased — size 10½x5x3¼ inches and they have a built in thermostat and fan to boost the average-size window greenhouse temperature 20 to 30 degrees. Later when you get "rich" you can think about putting up an "instant" lean-to greenhouse which a child can erect.

GREEN THUMB CLINIC:
 "Please tell us how to tell when winter squash or pumpkins can be harvested."
 Answer: These can be harvested when the rind of the fruit cannot be penetrated by the thumbnail. Fruit should be harvested before heavy frost since they are injured by cold temperatures. Cut the stem from the vine. Fruit without a stem will not store well.

Muskmelons pass prime eating quality rapidly. A mature melon will easily come off the vine with a gentle pull — this is called the "slip stage." Chill melons before serving. Slightly immature melons can be ripened by holding them at room temperatures.

Pesticides Are Safe

Does the use of pesticides bother you? It shouldn't according to the United Nations Food and Agriculture Organization.
 The FAO recently explained the safety of pesticides:

"Pesticides, like all chemicals, may have effects on other organisms living in the environment, including man himself: whether the effects occur or not is simply a question of dosage and of proper use."

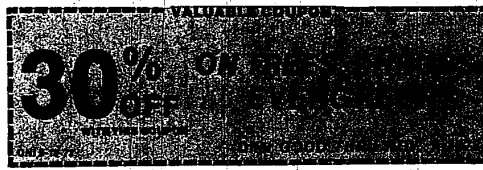
