

# 42 Groups In Bingo Parade

**An Observer Roundup**

Catholic church groups and veterans organizations lead Observeland groups who have obtained licenses for bingo since the popular game was legalized in July.

To date, 42 local organizations have applied for and received licenses for bingo, either as a weekly activity or one-time fundraisers.

Of the 42 organizations, 15 are Catholic groups and eight are veterans organizations. Catholic church groups have long been noted as using bingo games as a means of raising funds.

All non-profit groups are eligible for the licenses, which are available from the lottery bureau in Lansing.

**How Drug Committee Gives Help**

Q: What is this "CCODA" I saw in the paper a while back?

A: The Community Commission on Drug Abuse (CCODA) is a non-profit corporation funded by residents of Clarenceville, Livonia and Westland. CCODA is a concerned group whose aim is to provide aid in drug education, counseling, day care, drug analysis, speakers bureau, etc.

The individuals who work at CCODA are students, lawyers, housewives, and others from all walks of life. The CCODA family is a melting pot of various ages and experiences.

We all share one common point—a feeling of commitment to help others—and this is the basis for all involvement in CCODA.

Q: Do students get credit for working for CCODA?

A: Yes. Students who want to work as a volunteer for CCODA, should contact their counselor who handles community service projects and asks it from there. For those interested, a new training program will be starting the beginning of November for phone volunteers. For details, call Westland Aide Center at 261-3760.

Q: What is DMT?

A: DMT, an abbreviation for dimethyltryptamine, produces LSD-like trips and is short acting, lasting from one-half hour to four hours. DMT is a synthetic derivative of tryptamine; chemically related to psilocybin and LSD.

Use of DMT causes increased pulse and blood pressure and carries the dangers of hallucinogens in general, such as the user risking health, sanity and possibly their lives if DMT is mixed with other drugs.

**know no fault**

Michigan has passed a brand new no-fault auto insurance law which is effective October 1, 1973. Here's how it affects you:

If you own a car, truck, bus, or trailer, you must have this insurance. If you don't, you could be fined \$500, jailed for one year and lose your driver's license and license plates. Two-wheeled motorcycles are not included.

To get your Michigan license plates you must prove you have this insurance. If you don't have a policy, you must buy one.
