Farmington's crime rate continued to drop in August, with the most noticeable decrease in burglaries, according to a monthly report submitted to the Farmington City Council.

There have been 37 burglaries reported so far this year, compared to 76 last year at the same time.

One armed robbery has been reported, compared to five last year at the same time.

Larceny of bicycles and accessories has climbed up from 88 last year to 147 this year.
