High Holy Days Services Set

Jewish congregations in the Observerland are preparing for the High Holy Days, beginning at sundown Thursday, Sept. 27. Rabbi Martin D. Gordon will officiate for services planned by the Livonia Jewish Congregation, 3180 W. Seven Mile, Livonia. Services are scheduled Sept. 26, 27 and 28 and Oct. 5 and 6. Adat Shalom Synagogue, which recently dedicated its new complex of buildings at 2901 Middle Belt, Farmington, plans several special features for its services. One of them, reinstating of the Tashlich ceremony at 6:15 p.m. Thursday, Sept. 27, comes about because the synagogue property includes a pond stocked with fish. The ritual, performed on the first day of Rosh Hashanah, the Hebrew New Year, is an acting out of the Micah passage "And thou wilt cast all their iniquities into the depth of the sea." In the ceremony, those participating go to a body of water that has fish in it and, after reciting prayers, shake the skirts of their garments over the water as if they were casting sins upon the water.

Adat Shalom also will have an exhibit during High Holy Days featuring a selection of rare manuscripts and Mahzorim on loan from the Jewish Theological Seminary of America. The synagogue's Slichot service, scheduled to begin at 11:15 Saturday, Sept. 29, will be preceded by a coffee hour beginning at 9:30 p.m. and a film, "A Chassidic Tale." Rabbi Jacob E. Segal and Rabbi Seymour Rosenblum will lead the services, with Cantor Nicholas Fenkel and the synagogue choir chanting the liturgy. The Birmingham Temple, 2811 W. 12 Mile, Farmington, will mark the holiday week with a discussion by Rabbi Sherman Wine on "The New Year - Predictions" at 8:30 p.m., Friday, Sept. 28. A discussion of the lecture will follow.
