Michigan has passed a brand new no-fault auto insurance law which is effective October 1, 1973. Here's how it affects you:

If you own a car, truck, bus, or trailer, If you own a car, truck, bus, or trailer, you must have this insurance. If you don't, you could be fined \$500, jailed for one year and lose your driver's lice and license plates. Two-wheeled motocycles are not included.
