October is National Apple Month, so why not a "caramel apple-ing" party to help celebrate?

Making caramel apples is perfect party fun because it will interest the seasoned chef as well as the novice cook in your group - who will, of course, delight in adding to his repertoire.

Choose any favorite apple variety and allow to warm to room temperature before dipping. After the crisp apples have been coated with rich creamy caramel, these delicious - and nutritious - confections can be trimmed in any number of interesting ways.

Although this recipe suggests dressing the caramel apples with candy corn, you might also consider marshmallows, chopped nuts, coconut or other candies.

Perhaps your guests would even enjoy bringing trimmings to the party themselves.

When the evening waxes old, and cooks and artists have put away their tools, you'll want to serve some simple additional treats to round out the party fare.

Cider and brittle crispies, a coral cookie full of marshmallow and peanut-brittle surprises, will add to your guests' enjoyment of their delectable caramel apple creations.

Caramel apples are best in autumn when fresh juicy apples are in greatest abundance. Dairy-fresh caramels are always available in convenient 14-ounce bags - just the right size for one batch of caramel apples. And in fall, you'll find them with wooden sticks packed right in the bag in your grocer's produce section, alongside the apples, as well as on the candy shelves.

Melt caramels with water in covered double boiler or in saucepan over low heat. Stir occasionally until sauce is smooth. Insert a wooden stick into stem end of each apple. Dip into hot caramel sauce turning until coated. Scrape off excess sauce from bottom of apples. Place on greased waxed paper; chill until firm. Keep in a cool place.

BRITTLE CRISPIES
1 c. miniature marshmallows
1/4 c. margarine
4 c. crisp rice cereal

1 c. crushed peanut brittle
Melt marshmallows with margarine in a saucepan over low heat; stir occasionally until smooth. Remove from heat. Stir in cereal and candy. Press into a greased nine-inch square pan and cool. Cut into squares. Serve with apple cider.

City Planning Is Topic For League

Mary Childs and Russell Ash, chairmen of the planning commissions for the City of Plymouth and Plymouth Township, will be speakers for the Plymouth Northville League of Women Voters Thursday, Oct. 11.

The meeting will be held at 8 p.m. in the commission chambers of Plymouth City Hall. The program is public.

Mrs. Jane Watts, LWV president, said the meeting is designed as an introduction to the league's forthcoming study of procedures and policies to aid orderly growth of the entire Plymouth community.

Members of the LWV local study group will chair the session, with each planning commission chairman presenting a brief synopsis of the current status of planning and zoning in the city and township. The speakers will answer questions from the floor.

The coming league study will include an analysis of present planning and how it relates to physical, environmental and social needs.

Existing plans regarding parks and recreation areas, residential areas and business and commercial development will be evaluated.

Mothers-To-Be Are Offered New Annapolis Course

Mothers-to-be can learn more about the birth process and hospital facilities in Annapolis Hospital, 3355 Annapolis, Wayne.

The six-week course, offered by the Peoples Community Hospital Authority, will be held from 10 a.m. to noon on Saturdays in the hospital. The next course is scheduled to begin in late October or early November.

The course will consist of a tour of the labor and delivery areas and the nursery, and a childbirth movie, according to Mrs. Ann Harkins, the instructor who is also head nurse in the delivery room at Annapolis.

"We teach basic anatomy, fetal development, nutrition, pre and post-natal exercises, anesthetics, breast feeding, and baby care and bathing," said Mrs. Harkins.

"In addition," she continued, "the women are taken on a tour of the labor and de-

livery areas and the nursery. They are also shown a movie of an actual birth. With these adjuncts to the party book-work sessions, the women have an informed concept of the birth process and the hospital facilities."

Mrs. Harkins has been with PCHA at Annapolis Hospital for two years.
