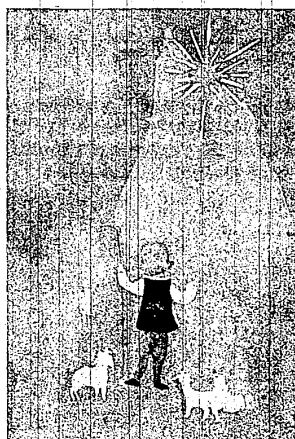

Nursery Still Has Places

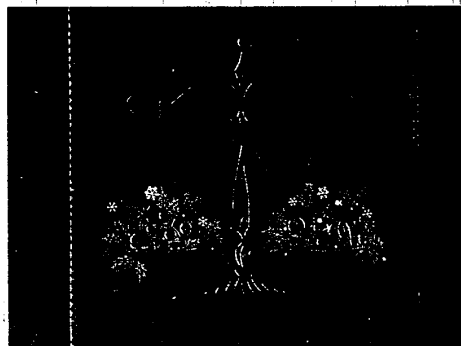
Salem Co-operative Nursery, Salem and Grand Rivers, Detroit, is accepting applications for three-year-olds until Dec. 1.
