Films from Switzerland, Great Britain, Denmark and Brazil have been selected for Fine Arts Film Series' presentations during the fall semester at Schoolcraft College.

### Wildlife Film Series Set

The Detroit Audubon Society's annual wildlife film series kicks off this season on Oct. 6 with a presentation of the "Florida Cypress Sanctuary" and "Fish Eating Creek" by Richard Kern.

Presentations are scheduled for 7:30 p.m. in the Rackham Auditorium, Woodward and Farnsworth, next to the Detroit Art Institute. A free children's matinee is offered at 2 p.m. the same day.

The series consists of seven films and season tickets are available.

Two films scheduled for this month include "LaSalamandre" on Oct. 12. Produced in Switzerland in 1971, it has French dialogue with English subtitles. "The Belles of St. Trinians," a 1955 British film, will be shown Oct. 25.

"Day of Wrath," a 1943 Danish film with Danish dialogue and English subtitles, is scheduled for Nov. 16. On Nov. 30 an evening of short films has been planned with titles to be announced later.

A Brazilian film, "Black God, White Devil," will be shown Dec. 7. It has Portuguese dialogue and English subtitles.
