Dr. R.C. Dunkelberger **Enters New Ministry**

Dr. Richard C. Dunkelberger of Livonia is exchanging a "flock" of about 2,000 for one of just under 300 and in the process entering a completely different kind of min-

istry. After 13 years as pastor of Rosedale Gardens United Presbyterian Church, the well - known clergyman will leave Nov. 1 to become executive director of Presby-terian Village, located in Redford Township.

He'll preach his last ser-mon on Oct. 28 in the church he helped build. Then, from 4 to 6 p.m., the congregation will honor him and his wife, Marilee, with a farewell reception in the Fellowship

"I've been preaching since 1943 and have loved every minute of it," said Dr. Dunkeiberger, who served a church in Sturgis before coming here. "I'm certainly not leaving the preaching

ministry because of any dissatisfaction.

"But after 30 years it seemed a good idea to have Sundays free for an occasional weekend away.

He said leaving Rosedale was a difficult wrench -- "it was while living here that our three children grew up and were married."

"People think of a congregation depending on its pas-tor," he added, "but it's also true in a very real way that a pastor becomes dependent on his congregation.'

In his new post, Dr. Dun-kelberger is the first clergyman among three directors to head the retirement home.

He has been a member of the Village's board of directors for 10 years and when Edwin Kibert announced plans to retire was asked if he would consider the work.

"I had decided I wouldn't leave Rosedale for another church," he said, "but this seemed a new opportunity. I'm leaving the parish, but definitely not the ministry.'

He will be in charge of all operations of the Village, established by the Detroit Presbytery and located at 23600 Six Mile, Redford Township.

The home is composed of separate residences for re-tired people, and Dr. Dunkelberger pointed out that their average age is about 80.

"The thing that always has impressed me about this place," he said, "is that people come here to live, not

A full calendar of activities always is part of Village life, he added, and there have been so many applications from would-be residents that waiting lists were closed about a year ago.

Dr. and Mrs. Dunkelberger will stay for a while in the Rosedale Gardens parsonage while the church's pulpit committee begins a search for a new senior minister.
