Concert Features Holiday Program

The Plymouth Symphony's concert Sunday at 4 p.m. will feature other Christmas music besides Handel's "Messiah."

Conductor Wayne Dunlap and the orchestra will be joined by the Kenneth Jewell Chorale in an entire program of holiday music.

Among the works will be "Rise Up Shepherd, and Follow" (arr. Parker), "Hail Mary" (arr. Dawson), "Cherry Tree Carol" (Nova Scotia melody, arr. Applebaum), "Bring A Torch" (arr. Shaw Parker), "The Holly and the Ivy" (Shaw-Parker), "Carol of the Bells" (Leontovich-Wilhousky) and "In the Bleak Midwinter" (arr. Holst).

Main feature will be the Christmas portion of "Messiah," which Handel wrote in 1742. It was first performed

in Dublin, Ireland in the Easter season that year.

The performance will be in Plymouth's Salem High School, Joy east of Canton Center roads.

Tickets at \$3 for adults and \$1.50 for students are available in advance at Heide's Flowers and the Record and Tape Center in downtown Plymouth.

Qualified baby-sitters will be on duty at the school.

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
