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Madonna To Host College Evaluation

Madonna College will co-sponsor with the National Council for the Accreditation of Teacher Education a training session for evaluators at its Livonia campus, Dec. 13 through 15.

"It is the first such training program for evaluators," said Sister Mary Karen, chairman of Madonna's department of education, "and should be valuable in assuring consistency between the several teams."

New team members, representing education groups throughout the United States, whose responsibility it will be to examine schools of teacher education, will be studying the NCATE standards of evaluation.

Mock seminars and interviews will be set up between evaluators and Madonna students, alumni, faculty, and administrators, to provide discussions of the processes of analysis, interview, and consensus-making.

Standards by which colleges of education are judged are: goals of the program, design of curricula, resources and facilities, evaluation, program review and planning, according to Sr. Karen.

Commitment of the college to teacher training as reflected in their budget, administrative interest in the program, and the faculty's responsiveness to needs of students is also important, she said.

Madonna College was selected as the site of the training because it typifies the smaller teacher education institution. During the orientation, new evaluators will also visit Eastern Michigan University, typical of larger and graduate schools of education.

Evaluation, which usually takes place at a college of education every 10 years, was completed at Madonna College in 1972, with the college receiving full accreditation.
