Safety Glass Required In Michigan

As of July 1 this year, 29 states had passed regulations requiring the use of safety glass in patio doors, shower enclosures, storm doors, and any other potentially hazardous locations of glass in the home.

Statistics on the high incidence of annual home accidents that could have been prevented if safety glass was used triggered the legisla-

The 29 states with such legislation include: California, Colorado, Delaware, Florida, Georgia, Hawaii, Illinois, Kentucky, Louisiana, Maryland, Massachusetts, Michigan, New Jersey, New York, Ohio, Oklahoma, Oregon, Pennsylvania, Tennessee and West Virginia.

In addition, approximately 17 states have a model safety glazing law on their state legislatures' agenda.

If these bills are passed, almost all of the 50 states would require safety glazing

to help deter home injuries.

New construction obviously must conform to the states' legislation. But the emphasis of safety glazing legislation is also applied to the replacement of ordinary annealed glass in hazardous locations in existing homes.

Safety glazing laws are not meant to restrict the builder or place undue cost on the homeowner, but to create a safe environment for U.S. families and their friends.
