

Prep Swimmers Open

Clarenceville and Westland John Glenn opened their respective 1973-74 swim campaigns with victories while Livonia Franklin dipped into the loss column.

Clarenceville won the 400 freestyle relay by way of a Crestwood disqualification and captured seven individual events to topple the Dearborn crew, 95-79.

Glenn won the 400 yard freestyle relay in 3:40.2 and splashed by Ypsilanti, 89-83, while Franklin fell to Wayne, 87-85.

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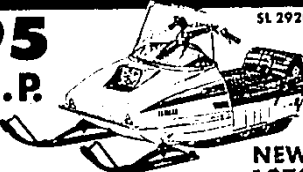
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
