Better Milk; More Money.

Prof. W. A. Stocking at Carlton, Ontario county, N. Y., told dairy farmers that the problem before the dairymen today is how to make a better quality of milk and greater return for it. This increased cost of feed and labor has materially increased the cost of production. At the same time the public is demanding a cleaner and more wholesome quality of milk. During the past few years the price of milk has increased quite materially and we probably can not hope to have it go much higher under present conditions.

The only way, therefore, for the farmer to get bigger returns is to lessen the cost of production. This can be done by keeping better cows. The demand for cleaner milk is in accord with other pure food work. The milk consumers have a right to demand that their milk should be produced and handled in a clean fashion. The general impression in the minds of dairymen is that clean milk means expensive buildings and equipment. This, however, is not true. There are not many dairymen who can not produce clean milk without much increase in cost if they know how to do it.

What the dairymen should have clearly in mind is the fact that dirt and dust are the chief sources of contamination and that any condition which produces dust in the stable or allows dirt to collect where it can get into the milk is sure to injure the quality of the milk. This means that any operation which will stir up the dust should be performed just before the milking is done, because all these operations stir up dust which will settle in the milk and thus injure the sanitary and keeping qualities.

The three things which will give the greatest improvement in the quality of the milk and which can be done at very little increase in cost are:

1. The use of a small top milk pail. This will keep out from one-half to nine-tenths of the dirt and bacteria which would fall into an ordinary large top pail.
2. The use of a damp cloth to wipe the udder and flank of the cow just before milking. This operation takes but a few seconds and removes the loose hair and particles of dust which would otherwise fall into the milk. This operation will very materially reduce the contamination of the milk and decidedly increase its keeping quality.
3. Milk should be cooled as soon as possible after milking to as low a temperature as possible.

Good Work.

The Cemetery association purchased and set out over 200 plants and shrubs in Oakwood cemetery last week. The work was supervised and participated in by the advisory board which consists of Mrs. F. M. Warner, Mrs. Minnie Wilber and Harry Weaver, a most enthusiastic and indefatigable trio, who are filled with public spirit and enterprise and are not afraid to back up their theories with good honest manual labor. Through the kindness of Mrs. Warner, Mr. Taft, landscape gardener from the Agricultural college, who was doing some work for her, visited the cemetery and gave the committee many valuable suggestions regarding the work they had to do. Shrubby has been purchased for the Quaker cemetery and will be set out immediately on its arrival. The committee are taking steps to have the broken monuments in the cemetery repaired, although resident lot owners are expected to look after those on their own lots. This is a noble work and every good citizen should lend his aid to help it along.

Be Careful.

The state oil inspector in his quarterly report calls attention to the frequency of accidents resulting from pouring gasoline in a tub of hot water for washing purposes. Gasoline emits a highly explosive vapor at 70 degrees temperature, the heat of an ordinary room. In a tub of hot water the vapor forms much more rapidly and the danger is correspondingly increased. The room is at once filled with gas and is quickly exploded from any artificial light (electric excepted), stove or heater in the room and the result is usually serious injury to life and property.

Distributed Large Sum.

County Treasurer John Power has compiled the amount of money raised during the past year through fines in the courts and finds that the total amount of money received by the county from this channel is \$2,369.25. This money goes into the school library fund and is to be distributed among the townships of the county at the rate of 25 cents for each child of school age.

The superintendent of public instruction recently sent a statement to the county treasurer showing that 9,477 children in Oakland county were entitled to share in the apportionment of library money. Each township receives its share according to the size of district and number of school children residing therein.

In addition to the amount of library money sent to the township treasurers on Monday their hearts were made glad with their share of the primary money apportionment which was mailed at the same time. The total amount of primary money distributed in the county this spring is \$54,195.

The money from the library and primary funds is sent to the township treasurer who retains possession of the primary fund, but turned the library money to the school inspector who proceeds to use it to purchase library books for his own school district—Pontiac Press Gazette.

General Notes.

Senator Aitkin's book bill passed the senate, that of Senator Tuttle's being killed. This bill is to establish uniform text books in the schools. The bill provides for a state board to pass upon the eligibility of all school book publishers being obliged to submit samples and school boards are given the right to choose such books as they desire.

Both houses of the legislature have passed the Free Tuition Bill. This provides that school districts must pay the tuition of students in one of three convenient high schools up to \$20 per year. In order to share in this pupils must have completed the state eighth grade examination. Parents must notify the district board of their intention to take advantage of the law before the fourth Monday in June of each year.
