Fishing Fees Go Unchanged


LANSING Nearly 1.5 million 1974 Michigan fishing licenses are being distributed to the state's 2,800 license agencies, reports the Department of Natural Resources.

The fee structure will remain the same as in 1973. Residents will pay \$3.25 to fish for all species except trout and salmon, which require an additional \$3.25 stamp.

Senior resident fishing licenses, good for all species, will sell for 75 cents; non-resident, \$6.25; seven-day non-resident, \$5.25; three-day licenses, \$2.25; and one-day licenses, \$1.25.

Several students at Clarenceville Senior High School have become the Red Cross blood program's first 17-year-old blood donors in the southeastern Michigan area.

Because of a recent directive from the Committee on Standards, made up of the American Red Cross, the Federal Bureau of Biologics and the American Association of Blood Banks, and under the guidance of the Michigan Department of Health, 17-year-olds are now eligible to donate blood.

The first-time donors joined their 18-year-old classmates and faculty in voluntarily donating blood at a Red Cross bloodmobile visiting the school.

Jack Stallings, a 17-year-old from Livonia, said many of the students promoted the bloodmobile visit.

"When many of the teachers gave us reasons why they couldn't donate," Stallings said, "we 17-year-olds decided to do it ourselves."

The new ruling provides that 17-year-olds can now donate blood provided that they have parental consent and that a physician is present to give permission following a review of the donor's history and medical examination. Formerly the minimum age of donation was 18 years.

"It didn't hurt at all," Stallings added. "When we were through donating, the volunteers chattered us around like we were a million bucks."
