She is the horticulture chairman of the group's District 1, second vice president of the Federated Garden Clubs of Michigan, and a master flower show judge.

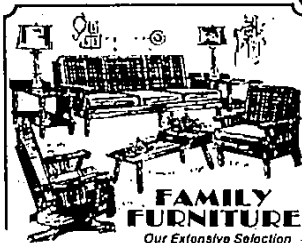
She is Michigan's only accredited flower show school instructor in horticulture.
