

Why new classified section better for all

Starting Monday, home owners and businessmen in Wayne and Oakland counties interested in selling anything from used furniture to new cars and homes will be able to reach an expanded market of buyers.

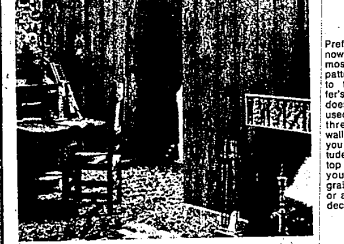
