Late start on C'ville agenda

Clarenceville schools will remain on their present later starting and closing times if the Board of Education follows its superintendent's recommendation at Thursday's meeting.

Supt. David McDowell said a poll showed parents voting 2 - 1 to continue the later hours imposed with the advent of daylight savings time.

"The staff vote was split down the middle," he said. Supt. McDowell said he also will recommend closing of Westbrook Elementary School because of a decline in school population. Trial date in the \$500,000 damage suit filed against the board by a former teacher, Joseph Kerr, has been set for April 9, McDowell said. Kerr's suit is an outgrowth of the district's failure to rehire him five years ago after he worked there as a probationary teacher, the superintendent explained.

Other items on tonight's school board agenda include a proposal to initiate a vandalism prevention program and a decision regarding security in all the district's buildings.

Baccalaureate to be optional at Clarenceville

Whether the traditional baccalaureate exercises are held at Clarenceville High School will be left to each year's senior class.

Attendance at the annual exercises has steadily declined until last year only 33 students attended the ceremony, according to Ray Renbarger, principal of the high school.

"Many neighboring school districts have discontinued these exercises," he added. The Clarenceville school board, in voting to put the decision to the students involved, left room for the trend to reverse itself and baccalaureate exercises to return to fashion.

In other action, the school board asked the administration to draft a policy which might allow students who are deficient by only a credit or two to participate in commencement. The board will act upon this at a future meeting.
