Make a comfortable bed from an orange crate or carton. Make sure you line the carton with a removable material like a newspaper—the puppy has little control over his bladder and howels. Also, you can help ealm his fears with something warm like a hot water bottle. It may make him feel that he is back at his mother's side.

Chill.




