Detroit seeking 17th district nod

Dennis Shrewsbury of Detroit announced he is a candidate for the 17th Congressional District Democratic nomination.

Shrewsbury will seek the seat being vacated by the retiring Congressman Martha Griffiths. The district includes Southfield, Lathrup Village, Farmington Hills, Farmington and parts of Detroit.

The 33-year-old Shrewsbury said he quit his job as an insurance adjuster to campaign fulltime. He is campaigning alone without help from a campaign manager or organization.

"Too many elected officials have forgotten they are servants of the people and not servants of some special interest group or corporation who will finance their political campaign," Shrewsbury said.

TO OVERCOME this trend, he said he feels it is time for more "non-professional politicians" to be elected to office.

Shrewsbury was graduated from Cass Technical High School in 1959. He attended Wayne State University and then joined the U.S. Coast Guard in 1961. After his discharge in 1965 he worked in Washington, D.C., for a year and then returned to Detroit.

For the past six years he has worked as an insurance claims investigator for various firms in the Detroit area.

In January 1970 he began attending Macomb County Community College. He later transferred to Mercy College of Detroit where he will graduate in December with a bachelor's degree in political science.

Shrewsbury and his wife Brenda live at 12039 Glastonbury, Detroit. They have two children.

Man found dead in cottage fire

FARMINGTON HILLS — A 28 year old Farmington Hills man was dead on arrival at Botsford General Hospital in Farmington Hills following a fire in his cottage at the Boys Republic, 28000 W. Nine Mile.

William McDonald was found, lying fully clothed in a bathtub in his home, by Farmington Hills firemen who responded to a call from McDonald's neighbors.

The county medical examiners office said the cause of death is unknown pending the toxicologists report.

Farmington Hills police who

investigated the fire believe the fire originated in a mattress in the bedroom area of the cottage.

McDonald, who was employed as a supervisor at the Boys Republic, was home alone when the fire occurred. His wife, Justine, had gone to a relatives home for the day.

Funeral services were held at the Fred Wood cemetery Funeral home, in Livonia, on Tuesday June 18 at 1 p.m.

McDonald is survived by his wife and his mother, Clara McDonald.
