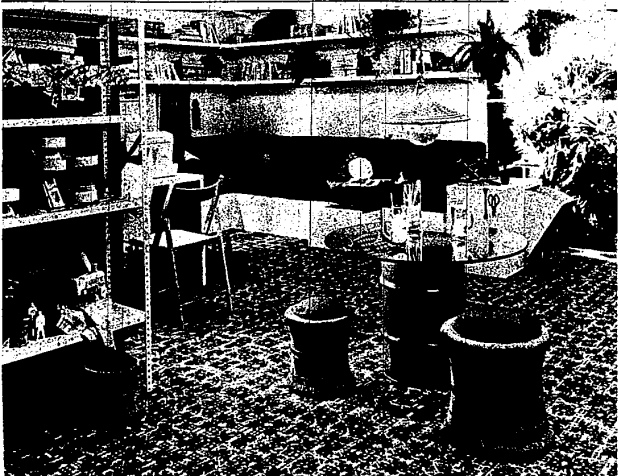

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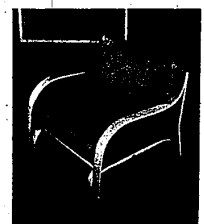
Arbor requires sturdy frame

When building a free-standing garden arbor or gazebo, frame it sturdily—and that usually means with 2x4-inch lumber.

Lattice and other fill-in work can be 1x1, 1x2, or 1x4-inch strips, which will provide an airy effect while supporting climbing shrubs or vines.

Western lumber in No. 2 grade is both strong enough and good looking, although pieces handpicked from a lower grade would be adequate and cheaper.

If posts are to be set into the ground, they should be heartwood cedar, or any other western species that is pressure treated.
