

Trustees favor elimination of tax board

BIRMINGHAM — A light school board agenda for Tuesday's regular meeting was made even lighter when a scheduled priority audit report and discussion of school district priorities for 1974-75 was postponed.

Dr. Alex Kloster, Michigan State University professor who was to present the audit report, was not able to be present because of illness. The report will be given at a later date.

The board approved a resolution favoring the elimination of the Oakland County Tax Allocation Board and permanently establishing a county non-voted property tax.

The board also indicated support of two proposals currently before the tax allocation board to establish the maximum county tax rate at either \$15 or \$15.25 per \$1,000 of equalized valuation of which \$8.50 per \$1,000 would be allocated for each school district.

In the past, the total non-voted tax rate has been set at 15 mills (15 per \$1,000 of equalized valuation) with the amount allocated for school districts varying annually.

The board asked Dr. Donald Peckenpaugh, superintendent, to

proceed with establishment of a Community Education task force.

The task force would be composed of representatives from the community including persons who already have been active in forming community education groups in the school district.

In other business Tuesday the board approved reappointments of

Dr. Ruth S. Day as consulting psychiatrist from September 1974 through June 1975, the firm of Keller, Thoma, Toppin and Schwarze as general counsel and the firm of Clerk, Hardy, Lewis and Fine as labor relations counsel, both for the 1974-75 school year.

BOARD COMMITTEE repre-

sentatives also were appointed as follows: Jane Johnson, Michigan Association of School Boards designate; John Dixon, Oakland Intermediate Schools designate with Donna Hartwig as alternate; and Gary Petersen, Task Force 23 designate with Dorothy Eicker as alternate.

Other appointments included

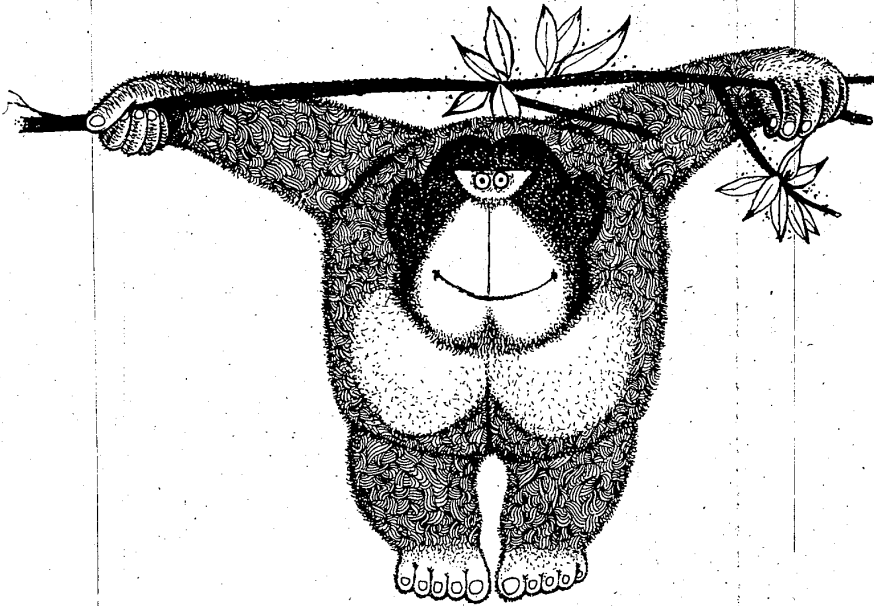
Ralph Sosin as designate and Mrs. Johnson as alternate to the legislative committee; Mrs. Eicker, designate to the Birmingham Youth Assistance Committee; Robert S. Ketchum, designate to the Community House Board of Trustees and Mrs. Hartwig, designate to the Birmingham Student Loan and Scholarship Fund.

An open board study session will be held at 8 p.m. Tuesday at the administration building, 550 W. Merrill. Topics to be discussed include a data processing report and changes in the budget.

The next regular board meeting will be held at 8 p.m. Tuesday, Aug. 13, instead of Aug. 6.
