Mime artist performs

Geoffrey Buckley, internationally-known mime artist, will give three performances at "The Theatre" of the University of Detroit/Marygrove College Performing Arts Center, in conjunction with a two-week residency at Marygrove College.

Buckley will present "Geoffrey Buckley in White Partonime" on two consecutive Saturdays July 27 and Aug. 3 at 8:30 p.m., portraying his character of Pierrot the clown. A shortened performance will be

presented for children on Aug. 3 at 3 p.m., billed as "Geoffrey Buckley's Colossal One Man Travelling Clown Show."

The character of Pierrot the clown belongs to the commedia dell'arte tradition. Speaking through mime rather than words, he communicates the characteristic gestures of the human race in a continuous performance of pathos, drama, comedy and silence.

BUCKLEY WILL present his

character of Pierrot at the International Mime Festival to be held this year in LaCrosse, Wis.

He is also a director, mimeographer and lecturer in dramatic mime. He studied at the Lecoq Academy of Dramatic Mime in Paris and has appeared at international festivals and competitions as well as his work in film and television.

This is Buckley's fifth tour of the United States, and his third

visit to Detroit — he last appeared here when he taught in the University of Detroit's Third Summer School for the Performing Arts.

He is teaching two workshop classes in classical mime, and one in commedia dell'arte; the classes run through Aug. 2.
