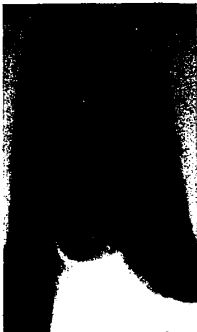




Rosenbaum-Segal
