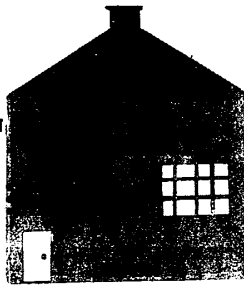

# C'ville reduces operating millage

For the second year in a row, the Clarenceville Board of Education voted to reduce operating millage for the coming school year.

The decision to reduce the millage by .51 of a mill came at the Aug. 22 school board meeting. The board has now reduced its operating millage .90 of a mill over the past two years.

The reduction in taxes does not mean that there will be a cut in the number of programs the schools offer, Edward Salisz, Clarenceville business manager, explained.

The reduced taxes are a result of a school closing, a decrease in the number of elementary teachers hired due to a decrease in student enrollment this year, and the failure to fill the assistant superintendent post when it was vacated, Salisz noted.

The board also announced that all its teacher positions for the 1974-75 school year have been filled. The board also approved a six per cent pay hike for administrators while turning down a proposal to increase the pay rate for substitute teachers.

Other board action included a report on the cost of damages which resulted from a break-in of Edgewood Elementary School. The damage costs were estimated at \$2,000.

Also, the board approved taking out a state aid loan for \$700,000.

The proposed budget for the 1974-75 year will be brought up for approval at the Sept. 22 meeting, Salisz said. The next school board meeting is planned for Sept. 5.

## Rape bill is now law

Gov. William G. Milliken recently signed a bill which revises Michigan's 117-year-old rape law by recognizing rape as a violent crime first and as a sexual act second.

The bill redefines rape as a crime of sexual assault—recognizing four degrees of sexual assault—while protecting both male and female victims," Milliken said.

"It eliminates some of the impossible high requirements for 'proof' by dispensing with the dangerous requirement that the victim resist to the utmost.

"The new law is especially important because of the steady rise in the incidence of rape. Our new legislation is already becoming a model for the entire country."

Milliken also signed into law a bill which increases from six to eight per cent the maximum interest rate on money borrowed for school operating purposes in anticipation of state school aid.
