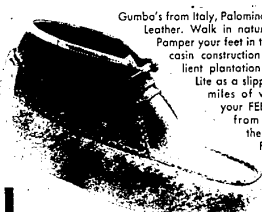
Red Hill, a member of the All-American Skeet team, opened the day with a demonstration of how it ought to be done, then turned his attention to teaching novices how to do it.

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12-year-old assaulted

A 12-year-old girl was dragged into a car in Ferndale Wednesday night (Oct. 9) by a man who drove her to locations in Beverly Hills and Southfield and assaulted her.

After the second assault, the girl told Beverly Hills public safety officers, he drove her back to Ferndale and let her go near her home.

The victim said she was walking along Woodward on her way to Ferndale High School to go swimming when her attacker drove up and asked directions to Ten Mile Road, police reports said.

The assailant was described as white with dark crew cut hair, clean shaven, about 30 years old, six feet tall and 215 pounds.

The victim said he was wearing grey cotton pants and a flannel shirt.



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
