

Adams wins, 24-16

Highlanders bounce Groves

The Adams Highlanders turned in their soundest performance of the season as they handed Birmingham Groves their fifth loss of the year, 24-16.

Kirk Durham had the best day of his career as the senior quarterback rushed for 110 yards and passed for 84. He also passed for one touchdown and converted on runs on all three extra point attempts.

Groves took the opening kick-off

and held the ball for the first nine minutes of the first quarter. However, they gave up the ball on downs deep in the Adams territory after moving 65 yards in 16 plays.

The Highlanders first play from scrimmage looked like the sudden swinge of momentum was going to doom the Falcons.

TOM LAWRENCE ran 29 yards off tackle and on the following play, Fred Schimon rambled 18 more yards and it looked like the start of an offensive field day for Adams.

But the Groves defense stiffened, and after two unsuccessful attempts at running the ball, the Highlanders took the air as Durham hit Jeff Nielsen for a 15 yard gain and another first down. They then reverted to their running game and picked up another first down but on fourth and two at the Falcon 18, they called on Schimon but he failed to pick up enough yardage for the first down. So just as Groves had done earlier, the Highlanders ran a well executed drive deep into the opponents territory, only to see it fizzle on a crucial fourth down play.

Groves got the ball on its own 16 but Jim Rugel fumbled on the first play and Adams' Brad Tallman recovered and the Highlanders had forced the first big mistake of the game.

The defensive spurt failed to fire the Adams offense up as they could not muster a first down on this drive and once again gave up the ball on downs deep in Falcon territory.

Groves got moving on offense again and after picking up 13 yards and a first down in four plays, they fumbled again as Ron Lunetta coughed up the pigskin and Roy Willard daringly picked it up and ran about 15 yards with it and that key defensive play resulted in the first score of the game.

AFTER TWO plays, Adams failed to move so they decided to go to the passing game again. It turned out to be the right decision as on third down and 14 Durham hit Matt Mette with a quicky and Mette carried the rest of the way into the endzone, completing a 17 yard scoring strike.

Durham ran in his first of three two-point conversions on the day and the Highlanders took the lead, 8-0.

Groves took the ensuing kick-off and Falcon coach Bill Rankin decided that he had seen enough fumbling and he too decided to go to his passing game. But the result was frustratingly the same as after an incomplete pass, quarterback Doug North threw an aerial to Lunetta but he also fumbled and Tom Lawrence recovered for Adams and it was the third fumble of the game by Groves.

Adams came out passing again and on first down Durham hit John Strayer with an 18 yard gain to set up another Adams score as they had the ball first and ten on the Falcon 17-yard line.

On second Durham picked up nine of his 110 yards rushing to give the Highlanders another first down and helped them maintain that so important momentum.

ON THE NEXT two plays, Adams called on tailback Schimon and he made runs of five and two yards, the latter giving Adams its second touchdown of the game, and Schimon his seventh touchdown of the season. Durham ran in the extra points and Adams held a 16-0 halftime lead.

The third quarter saw Groves take temporary charge of the game. Adams couldn't move on its first series and was forced to punt. The Falcons moved 87 yards on 10 plays with North hitting Lunetta on a screen pass gaining seven yards on the final play of the drive for the touchdown. Due to two

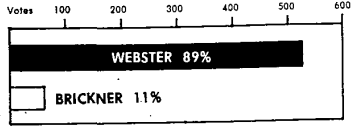
