Speaker suggests prize for Israel

More than 200 women attended Hadassah's annual "Woman of the Year" award on Oct. 22 at Congregation Shaarey in Southfield. Guest speaker at the Israel Bond affair honoring Mrs. Albert Newman was Charlotte Jacobson. Mrs. Jacobson is chairman of the American section of the Jewish Agency for Israel and a past national president of Hadassah. She currently serves on the higher education committee for Israel in the World Zionist Organization and has also been active since 1966 in the National Conference for Soviet Jewry.

"ISRAEL DESERVES a Nobel Peace Prize for what they have done to absorb immigrants," she said.

"They have to effectively accommodate the influx of Jews from Russia and other countries while at the same time meet the housing and economic needs of her own citizens."

She called the recent United Nations vote to allow Palestinian terrorists a platform "a turning point for the U.S. that will go down in history as its greatest blunder."

Following her speech, Mrs. Jacobson presented the Jerusalem

City of Peace Award to Mrs. Newman.

This is awarded for outstanding participation in the Israel Bond Program which is strengthening the economy of the State of Israel as the foundation for the spiritual and cultural re-birth of the Jewish People," she said.
