### LOCAL OPTION LAW

#### Search and Seizure Act Goes into Effect Sept. 1.

Many people wish to know what are the provisions of the liquor legislation adopted by the last session of the legislature. Particularly do they wish to know the provisions of "Dickinson's Search and Seizure law," under which it is claimed enforcement of the law will be far easier than at present. The leading provisions of this law have been compiled by a leading attorney and are published below. This law goes into effect next September:

"In relation to the so-called Dickinson bill, which passed the legislature at the last session amending the general local option law will say that the principal changes in the present law are:

"First—For the first offense the defendant is sentenced to pay a fine of not less than \$50 nor more than \$200 and cost of prosecution and to imprisonment in the county jail not less than 20 days nor more than six months in the discretion of the court, and for the second and every subsequent offense committed the fine is to be not less than \$100 nor more than \$500 and imprisonment in the state house of correction at Ionia for a period of not less than six months nor more than two years in the discretion of the court. The changes made are in fixing the minimum punishment.

"Second—The law requires every druggist keeping a drug store to make and swear to a true written statement signed by him self or his clerk on the first Monday of each month, giving the number of consignments of liquor received during the last previous month, the dates of consignments, the kind and quantity of liquors received and the name of the person, firm or corporation from whom such liquors were purchased.

"Third—Liquor can be sold or furnished directly or indirectly only upon the written (not printed or typewritten) prescription of a regular practicing physician, which prescription shall state the name of the person for whom the liquor is prescribed; it must be issued upon good faith and upon personal knowledge of the physician that that the physical condition of the person for whom the liquor is prescribed requires the same for medical purposes; or upon the written or signed application of the superintendent of any hospital, medical or educational institution where such liquors are used for scientific purposes. Before delivering any such liquor upon such prescription the druggist shall enter the full name and residence of the purchaser, the kind and quantity of liquor procured, the date of procuring the same, the object for which such liquor was procured, and having filled such prescription or application shall write on the face thereof the word "cancelled," together with the date when such prescription or application was filled and shall sign his name thereon. A true copy of all such prescriptions or applications filled by such druggist shall be filed with the prosecuting attorney of the county in which the store is located at the time of filing his report of sales as now required by law.

"Alcohol and other liquors shall be sold for art, chemical, scientific or mechanical purposes only upon the written application of the purchaser, subscribed and sworn to, which statement must be received by the druggist, cancelled, dated, signed and filed in the manner prescribed for medical prescriptions and applications.

"Fourth—The law further pro-

vides for the so called search and seizure; that is the issuance of search warrants for searching depots, freight houses, express offices or any other building or place where the party making the affidavit or complaint has good reason to believe and does believe that any liquors being manufactured, sold, furnished or given away as a beverage or kept for the purpose of being so used, or are stored temporarily or otherwise. It provides that upon making such search any liquors, furniture or implements may be kept by the officers authorized to make such search and seizure, such fluids shall be held to be prima facie intoxicating liquor and intended for unlawful sale. All shipments made E. O. D. shall be held to be sales made at the place of destination in violation of the provisions of this act.

"It also re-enacts the section of the general liquor law providing for the bringing in of drunken persons upon subpoena and their being committed to jail in case they do not tell where they procured the liquor.

"Fifth—The law also changes the rule of evidence and provides that proof of consumption or intended consumption of any of the liquors mentioned in the act by any person visiting, resorting to, or frequenting any place occupied by any person, corporation, club, association or society shall be prima facie evidence of the sale, giving away or furnishing of such liquor or beverage to such person in violation of the provisions of the act."

### State Lands for Sale.

In the counties of Alger, Arenac, Dickinson, Isabella, Roscommon, Saginaw and Wexford there are over 60,000 acres of homestead lands for sale, and as the land commissioner's department is trying to encourage the settlement of homesteads and the new public domain commission is given power to encourage the settlement of homestead lands; it is likely that the coming year will see much of this land disposed of in this way.
