buying by mail**

The Better Business Bureau of Metropolitan Detroit is offering helpful information to those doing their Christmas shopping by mail.

Most mail order companies are legitimate but some are not, the BBB warns.

Many problems that do arise in the mail order business are caused by people forgetting to include their names and/or addresses on orders. And some complain too soon.

Generally four to six weeks should be allowed for delivery before making a complaint.

THE BBB offers some tips for buying by mail:

- Carefully read catalogs and always keep a copy of the ad or brochure.

- Pay by check or money order and never in cash, and include any shipping or handling charges.

• Keep a record of your order including the date, name and address of the company, cancelled check, number of money order or bank check.

• Check your order promptly upon receipt to insure it is the item you ordered and that it is intact and satisfactory. Notify the company at once if it is not.

The BBB also advises that unrequested merchandise received in the mail may be considered a gift. Nothing can be mailed to you without your consent unless clearly marked as a free sample or as merchandise from charitable organizations asking for a donation. Either way, the merchandise is a gift. There is no obligation to return or pay for the merchandise.
