Center receives grant

The Music Hall Center for the Performing Arts has been approved for a Ford Foundation grant of \$125,000, over a two-year period, for an experimental program to involve inner city students and senior citizens in the performing arts.

This will enable the Music Hall Center to contribute more to the cultural life of the Detroit community.

This grant is three-fold, it includes first a student scholarship program which will bring 600 elementary and high school students to the theatre to see six dance or six theatre productions. These will be augmented by classroom discussions and demonstrations in the theatre on all aspects of dance and theatre.

A senior citizen scholarship program allowing 500 senior citizens to attend dance and theatre presentations is the second part, and an expanded media program designed to reach all segments of the community is the third segment.

WOODY MILLER, formerly of

the Detroit Repertory Theatre and Director of the Repertory Artist Galleries and Touring Exhibits, joined the Music Hall staff to administer the grant.

An advisory board will soon be selected to offer guidance to Music Hall Center so that the grant will have maximum impact.
