The decision of the German Con-

stitutional Court and the public reversal of New York physician Bernard Nathanson's vierpoint deserve further comment because both decisions are based upon the moral principle of "right-to-life." The post-war German constitution was written in an almosphere of reaction to the horror crimes which destroyed life during the inne of Nail Germany. Respect for life hit an all-time low with the holocaust of 6 million Jews. Wiped out with these 6 million men and women of dignity were innumerable persons who were declared until members of the "master race" due to physical, mental or governmental reasons.

THE POST-WAR West German Constitution of the right-to-life principle based upon his members of the "master race" due to physical, mental or governmental reasons.

THE POST-WAR West German government wrote into its new constitution a strong right-to-life clause which would forbid the destruction of human life in any form. The new German nation would not tolerate even the possibility of dismissing human life in any form.

Thus, the West German High Court rendered by a six-to-two decision that abortion violated the right-to-life principle of the German constitution. As a matter of

THE DECISION of New York's Dr. Nathanson is important because he has arrived at his personal moral conviction of the right-to-life principle based upon his experience as a doctor who had performed thousands of abortions and has now been morally confronted with his conscience. He now states, "I am deeply troubled by my own increasing certainty that I presided over 60,000 deaths." The impact of these three recent incidents should cause all of us to reflect more deeply about the continuing emerging moral principle of the right-to-life in the abortion debate.

The words of Dr. Albert Schweitzer are worth recalling: "If a man loses his reverence for all of life."
The judicial decision of the West German Constitutional Court and the personal conviction of reformed pro-abortionist Dr. Bernard Nathanson re-enforce the moral commitment of Albert Schweitzer.
