

Adventists adopt bicentennial goal

The focus of a bicentennial program launched this month by the Seventh-day Adventist denomination is to make the community more beautiful.

The program has received official approval from the American Revolution Bicentennial Administration of the U.S. Government and is called "Four Cs for Century Three." The four Cs include community beautification, campus beautification, camp beautification and character beautification.

"We are searching for a local project that the church can involve itself in," Pastor Paul Matacio of the Troy church said. "We have cleaned and repaired our own church plant thoroughly and made sure it represents the community in the best way. The trees for landscaping are awaiting persons gifts. Next we want to find something specific in the community that our

church can do to make it a better place to live in.

In related activities the local church has collaborated in the beautifying of Northfield Junior Academy run by Adventists in Troy and Warren. A new roof and the school and property have been made ready for fall.

Also, the new school property for a 10-grade school at Square Lake Road and Crooks is well kept up. The denomination will also help in upgrading the camp facilities that the church's state headquarters operates.

"One major concern of ours in the 4 Cs program is the pollution of body and spirit that afflicts our generation," Pastor Matacio added. "We believe America can be a better place to live in as each American does his share individually and collectively to strengthen the moral fiber of the nation."
