Recession causes road fund surplus

The recession has provided Farmington Hills taxpayers an unexpected bonus, according to Ralph D. Magid, director of public services.

Magid told the Farmington Hills City Council last week the city has accumulated a surplus in its road construction fund "due to the general slowdown in the construction industry."

"That surplus will enable the city to repair nearly six miles of major roads," he said.

"AN ANALYSIS of the major road fund indicates an estimated surplus of \$18,745 through Dec. 31," Magid explained. "The additional expenditure to improve our major roads will not be a strain on the road budget."

PART OF the surplus resulted when bids for the resurfacing of Freedom and Folsom roads were awarded at a price "substantially lower than the engineer's estimate," he added.

As of last June 30 the major road fund showed a balance of \$11,265. Current projects will cost the city \$23,500, Magid said.

On the director's recommendation the council authorized spending \$157,000 of the surplus for the purchase of major mile roads this year.
