who could benefit from the program. Parker is principal of Cloverdale Development Center and district supervisor for orthopedic and mentally handicapped programs. The Farmington center is one of five in Oakland County which offer a preschool program. All suffer a lack of students, possibly, Parker said, because physicians and health departments aren't aware of the center's services.

In response to the Michigan Mandatory Special Education Act. Cloverdale organized a nursery and pre-achool for children who demonstrate a sugnificant developmental lag. "The nursery, for children one month to three years, and the preschool, for children aged three to five, are strictly developmental, for those who have some kind of handcapping condition." Parker said

Communication skills begin with basic sounds and progress to to words and then sentences, according to an in-dividualized program prescribed by the Cloverdale speech pathologist.

To assess the level and consequent reeds of each child, the Coverdale Center has developed a diagnostic evaluation service which nucleus test-ing by a physical therapast, an occupa-tional therapast and a speech patholo-gist. A nurse, social worker and psy-chologist also are on the center's staff.

Besides the Cloverdale Developmental Training Center at 33000 Freedom Road. Farmington, there are five other centers. These include Hawthorne Center in Piontace. Wing Lake Center in Bloomfield Hills. Waterford Center and Oak Park Center.
